Greetings in the wonderful name of our Lord Jesus Christ. *“For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;” Ephesians 2:14-16* We not only pray that for the people we serve but you wherever you may be praying and supporting this work of the Lord. This present evil world does and will get you down and take you out of the will of God. Christ is coming, the fight is on and we need to walk worthy of our new name!!!!

We keep on receiving the blessing of the Lord though we are not worthy and are humbled by His graciousness. A church in Alabama has raised \$100,000 for this work to help put roofs on 100 new churches in the next 3 years. **WHAT A BLESSING PRAISE THE LORD!!!!** Please join with us in prayer that the Holy Spirit of God would reach out as we evangelize in Zambia, Congo, Botswana, Tanzania, and now Malawi. Without the Lord starting these works they will be as clouds without water. The desire is great amongst the people as we have the men and women ready to evangelize but the scope of this work will almost double the size. We need missionaries for strategic areas to help. As you know there is a missionary and his wife helping us now full time. We have 137 churches at this time and within 3 years more then 100 to add to that. As it stands now, I can only visit one church every 2½ years to encourage and love them up. Please pray for wisdom and the Lord to place deep in the hearts of men a willingness to help here in this growing work of God. Thank you!!!

September brought 40 students to the Bible Institute at the mission station alone. We have 11 in Luanshya and 9 in Mwinilunga. There are 35 in Pastors Training which is taught to our graduates in locations close to where they minister, usually in the bush. We have seen 106 souls come to the Lord this month and 53 baptisms in obedience to the Lord. We have had three new churches start and two new places to preach. We are so blessed and happy in the

Lord. Don't get me wrong the flesh is still bombarded by the world. Zambia is a third world country with government and social corruption in high places along with the devilish cultural and traditional issues handed down through the ages. But the Spiritual blessing far out weigh the physical.

October harvest was edifying and exhorting. We had a ladies conference with over 250 ladies present, that came to the mission to be fed from the word of God. The teaching was on culture and tradition and where it opposes the authority of the word of God. The ladies were not embarrassed to ask questions relating to women when my wife and the new missionary's wife were teaching. It is now November. Husbands and Pastors are bringing back favorable reports in seeing the change in their wives and members. **HALLALUGHA AMEN and AMEN!!!! GETTEM-GIRLS!!!!**

Our new missionaries, Randy and Julie, went to Lusaka for the conference in the capitol city. They both taught and Randy preached Friday through Sunday. Souls saved were counted at 122 and 24 were baptized that day. **PRAISE THE LORD, GOOD-GOODY!!!** This couple is such a blessing and help in the ministry. (Any of you speculating ... come on down the waters fine, even if it has crocks in it, God is there with us!!!!!!)

In reports from the churches there were 46 saved this month as we minister in discipleship and the book of Romans on Wednesdays and Friday.

Prayer request: Our desk computers (those we have all our data on for grades, finances, clinic and hospital etc.) are very old with programs from the 90's. Please pray we get blessed with updated models. We have four running for the business office, Bible Institute, Library/Translating office, and Clinic. Two of these are 1995 models.

We can only pray that the Almighty God will richly bless you in all you do for His honor and glory. Your love for us has been soooooo faithful and steadfast we can surely know you love us and be it known we love you beyond mortal words.
