We praise the Lord for sending us Randy and Julie Foster, who are now stationed at the mission with us. AN ANSWER TO 9 YEARS OF PRAYER!!!! I know now why God waited to send help. I had to mature in this ministry so as to be a blessing and encouragement to a new precious missionary couple as they go through culture shock and adjust to be an effective workman of the Lord in a foreign country. Along with Discipleship they took responsibility for the Sunday School Ministry that oversees 130 churches, getting materials, helping to set up curriculums, preaching and teaching from church to church. They are a blessed couple and are a great help to my wife and I. Many of you know that Dr. Bonner is now CEO of IAM Ministries. He has been getting donations of Bibles, Tracts, hospital equipment, medicines and many other important needs for this ministry. Praise the Lord for his tireless efforts in traveling and preaching all over the U.S., bringing the needs to the churches of America for Southern Africa.

WOW, in July we had a group from Kansas City come to put on our first Youth Camp. Ever since we have been here we had Youth Conferences. Praise the Lord we had a church desiring to host the youth in teaching, preaching and activities these sweet people never had before. Hundreds came from the churches

within a 50-mile radius. As I saw the joy and happiness on and in these youth on the soccer pitch, I stood in tears for 10 minutes. Never before in their life or the life of their parents and their grand parents had they used or seen hula hoops, run with water cups on their heads, thrown Frisbees etc. MAN WHAT A THING!!! When it came to hearing the word of God these young people's ears were perked up and ready. The group went to the boys and girls high schools, where in total there were 1,800 young people brought in to the assembly hall to listen to testimonies of the group. Three from KC are police and were in police uniforms, one from NY is an instructor and former World Champion in TaiKwonDo. The group also ministered to 80 police officers at a brief and preaching service. A total of 1,058 made professions of faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. AIN'T GOD GOOD, HALLALUJAH!!!! The group shed many tears and had many, many Jesus bumps and most of them are committed to coming back to minister to the youth again.

And again WOW as we had our annual conference. This year we had 5 Pastors from the US and one from South Africa come to preach and teach to the people of Zambia lost and saved alike. I could not do justice to the testimonies of these men of God in the writing of this prayer letter. I can only say they would bring you to tears and fill your hearts with joy unspeakable and full of glory. On Saturday after the morning service we had 104 submit in obedience to scriptural baptism after receiving the Lord Jesus Christ as their Saviour. PRAISE GOD, PRAISE GOD!!!!!!!!!!!! There were a total of 4,500 in attendances this year, as transportation cost has risen each year and many could not afford to come. Many got saved, we do not have a clear count, but it is in the hundreds.

All of you have been and are a great blessing to us with your prayers and or support along with cards and letters, it makes me shout for joy that I am in the family of God!!!! We are going on 10 years next May and we have seen thousands saved and lives changed, works established in three other countries.
