At night we were singing praises to the Lord along with the choirs from our churches. Then there was preaching by the visiting Pastor, Bro. Bonner and myself.

The group brought the former Heavyweight Champion of the World, Chris Byrd and his wife Tracy. He gave testimony of his meeting the Lord Jesus Christ and bowing to Him even as a World Champion. GET THIS, A BIBLE BELIEVING WORLD CHAMPION GIVING PRAISE TO THE LORD FOR SAVING HIM AND LIVING A LIFE THAT HONORS THE KING OF KINGS, PRAISE THE LORD, AMEN AMEN!!!! Hundreds went into the tent after services for direction, rededication or salvation.

We are blessed to have more and more student doctors visit each year. We had four doctors and

The testimony of their letters after they have gone back to the countries where they live or go to school bears proof to that. My wife Lorna is Director of the soon to be hospital and now clinic. She has also been voted in as the Chairlady of the finance committee of Churches Health Association of Zambia and Treasurer of the Board of Directors for the same. God is soooo good!!!! Next I am going to have her run for President of Zambia:):):)

July left Kevin and my wife and I to carry on as Brother Foster and his wife were officiating their oldest son's wedding in the USA. Kevin and I finished up the remaining weeks of Bible Institute, student Saturday Evangelism and Sunday preaching, as is our daily routine. We are still blessed to have four student doctors here with us until mid August. We are expecting more doctors and three more groups to come and minister right up to the first weekend of December which is the graduation of Bible Institute Students. Just to think 12 years ago we had 29 churches and only one group that visited us once a year. And now 196 churches, doctors and visitors from January to December. When I sit back and think on these things I can't believe what the Lord has done and is doing. Even as I write to you churches are being started and souls saved, while teaching of the truth is going on right now. Not only in Zambia but Sub-Sahara Africa because of your generosity in prayers and giving. What a thing and what a GREAT God we are blessed to call our Father!!! Hallelujah, Hallelujah, AMEN!!! Thank you for being a part of this work of God.
